



BAZZITE ESSENTIALS

ujust, the shortcuts built into Bazzite.

ujust turns common maintenance and troubleshooting tasks into short, memorable commands. Open a terminal and type **ujust** followed by a command name. Typing **ujust** by itself lists everything available, and the **Bazzite Portal** app offers many of the same tasks as clickable buttons if you'd rather skip the terminal entirely.

● EVERYDAY UPKEEP

update	Updates the system, all Flatpak apps, and containers in one go.
clean-system	Clears old container images, Flatpak leftovers, and update data to free disk space.
bios	Reboots straight into the BIOS / UEFI firmware screen.
bazzite-cli	Adds a nicer, more informative terminal prompt style.

● WHEN SOMETHING BREAKS

fix-reset-steam	Resets Steam to a fresh state without touching games, saves, or your library.
fix-proton-hang	Force-closes stuck Proton or Wine processes when a game won't relaunch.
restart-pipewire	Restarts the audio system, the quick fix for crackling or broken sound.
logs-this-boot	Shows all system messages from the current session, for tracking down what went wrong.
device-info	Gathers your system info into a shareable link, handy when asking for help.

● DUAL-BOOT & SECURE BOOT

regenerate-grub	Rebuilds the boot menu so Windows shows up properly alongside Bazzite.
setup-boot-windows-steam	Adds a Steam shortcut that reboots straight into Windows.
enroll-secure-boot-key	Registers the signing key needed for Secure Boot with an Nvidia card.

● EXTRAS WORTH KNOWING

enable-tailscale	Turns on support for Tailscale, the private networking tool.
setup-decky	Installs Decky Loader, a plugin system for Steam's Gaming Mode.
ujust --choose	Opens an interactive menu of every available command. If nothing else sticks, remember this one.

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KDE PLASMA DEFAULTS

Keyboard shortcuts worth learning.

These are the default shortcuts for **KDE Plasma**, the desktop Bazzite ships with. **Meta** is the key with the Windows-style logo. Every one of these can be changed under **System Settings → Shortcuts**.

● GETTING AROUND

Meta	Open the application launcher and search
Alt + Space	KRunner: launch apps, calculate, run commands
Alt + Tab	Switch between open windows
Alt + Shift + Tab	Switch windows in reverse
Ctrl + Esc	System Activity: running processes at a glance

● DESKTOPS & OVERVIEW

Ctrl + F1 - F4	Jump to virtual desktop 1 through 4
Ctrl + F9	Show all windows on this desktop
Ctrl + F10	Show all windows on every desktop
Ctrl + F7	Show windows of the current app only
Ctrl + F12	Show the desktop, minimize everything
Meta + Tab	Next Activity (its own layout and apps)

● TEXT & DOCUMENTS (NEARLY UNIVERSAL)

Ctrl + A Z X C V	Select all · undo · cut · copy · paste
Ctrl + Shift + Z	Redo
Ctrl + N S P F W	New · save · print · find · close tab
F5	Refresh

● LOCK, LEAVE & CAPTURE

Ctrl + Alt + L	Lock the screen	Ctrl + Alt + Del	Leave screen: log out, restart, shut down	Print Screen	Spectacle: capture full screen or a region
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● THE ACTIVE WINDOW

Alt + F4	Close the window
Ctrl + Q	Quit the whole application
Ctrl + Alt + Esc	Force-quit a frozen app by clicking it
Meta + ↑	Maximize
Meta + ↓	Minimize
Meta + ← / →	Tile to the left / right half of the screen
Alt + F3	Window menu: move, resize, keep on top

● ZOOM, DISPLAYS & HELP

Meta + = / -	Zoom the whole desktop in / out
Meta + 0	Reset zoom
Meta + P	Switch display setups (external monitor)
F1	Open the focused app's help manual
Shift + F1	"What's This?": click anything to learn it

● FILES (DOLPHIN & FILE DIALOGS)

Alt + ← / → / ↑	Back · forward · up one folder
Alt + Home	Jump to your home folder
Ctrl + L	Type a location to jump straight there
Ctrl + H	Show / hide hidden files
F2	Rename the selected file
Ctrl + Shift + N	New folder
F4	Terminal panel inside the file manager
Shift + Del	Delete permanently, skipping the trash
